Answer: **Please disregard the information in quotations. The requirement is simply looking for the availability of answer keys for all assignment/test questions for our teachers.**

5. Please provide additional information as to what is needed/required with regards to a bulk grading feature (item 43 on page 11 of the RFP for K-12 Online Curriculum and Student Learning Management System).

Answer: **Our teachers oftentimes have over 100 students on their roster and we would like the ability to grade a specific question on an assignment/test at the same time for all students, as opposed to opening each exam individually. This also applies to providing an overall grade to all students in the gradebook at the same time.**

6. Please clarify what is meant by item 5 on page 13 of the RFP for K-12 Online Curriculum and Student Learning Management System under Program/Course Navigation.
